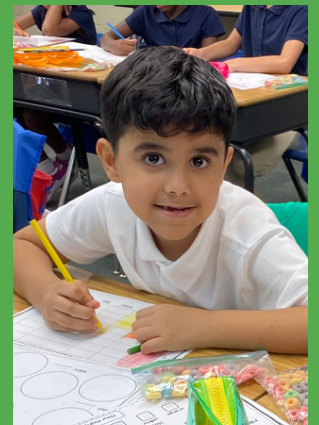


Montgomery Christian School Art Program

The art program's primary objective is for children to learn to observe, appreciate, and enjoy beauty in the arts. It is our purpose that while our students are engaged in any artistic activity, they are being uplifted and inspired. According to extensive research, children are able to retain more information when creativity and movement are involved. Especially as we teach children with poverty in mind, the curriculum must include the crossing of the left and right brain to further engage students for academic and life success.

The art program at MCS is centered around different methods to introduce students to the Master Artists. While using a variety of mediums, students create their own art project in the style of the artist they are studying. When a student has completed Kindergarten through 5th grade at Montgomery Christian School, he or she would have studied 42 Master Artists and will take home a portfolio of their own masterpieces.

The success of the program at MCS has taught our students to recognize the works of world renowned artists as well as develop a personal love and appreciation of art. Currently, several of our alumni are excelling in the arts, and a few are pursuing degrees in art at SCAD and other institutions.
